Fall 2010 SULC Faculty Colloquium Opening Changes to September 23

The opening of the 2010 Fall Faculty Colloquium has been changed to Thursday, September 23, with a presentation by Professor Winston Riddick.

Professor Riddick will present his research, “Haitian Immovable Property: Earthquake Recovery and Economic Development” at 12:15 p.m. in the faculty lounge on the second floor of A. A. Lenoir Hall’s North Wing. He has been invited to make a presentation on this research at St. Thomas University Law School in Miami, Florida, on November 5.

Professor Mark Thurmon will present “Patent Reform and the Seventh Amendment,” at 3 p.m., Wednesday, October 20, in the faculty lounge.

Closing out the fall colloquium on Thursday, November 11, Professor Okechukwu Oko will present “The Challenges of Democratic Consolidation in Africa.” Oko’s lecture will be held at noon also in the faculty lounge.

The colloquium provides an opportunity for faculty members to share their on-going research with colleagues and students. A senior faculty member leads a discussion on the presentation topic and opens the program to questions and comments from the audience.
