SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Third year required courses and third year-only electives will end on Wednesday, April 21, 2010, at 9 p.m.
2. Last day of mandatory class attendance for graduating students in all other courses will also be Wednesday, April 21, 2010 at 9 p.m.
3. In all courses, students who are graduating must inform their professors of this status by writing on their examination blue books or course papers "Graduating Student."
4. All graduating students enrolled in courses in which the final examinations are scheduled to be given after Saturday, May 1, 2010, are required to so inform their professors and they shall be given an examination no later than Thursday April 29, 2010.
5. Final grades for "graduating students" must be submitted to the Admission/Enrollment office as soon as possible, but no later than Friday, May 7, 2010.
6. Classes will end for first and second year students on Thursday, April 29, 2010, at close of business.
7. Final grades for first and second year students are due in the Admission/Enrollment office on or before Friday, May 21, 2010.
8. All examination blue books will be provided and distributed by professors.
9. All grades will be given only in strict compliance with regulations in the Law Center catalog.
10. All students are to report, as indicated, to the Office of Admission/Enrollment to obtain Personal Identification Numbers (PIN) for examination purposes between 9 a.m. and 8 p.m.
