SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Classes will end on Wednesday, April 17, 2019.
2. In all courses, students who are graduating, must inform their professors of this status by indicating on their examination – “graduating senior.”
3. Graduating seniors with conflicts must contact the Office of Academic and Student Affairs prior to April 6, 2019 to make arrangements to take a conflicting examination.
4. Final grades for “graduating students” must be submitted to the Department of Records and Registration as soon as possible, but no later than Friday, May 3, 2019, unless permission is received from the Office of Academic and Student Affairs for a later submission date for a conflict examination.
5. Final grades for non-graduating students are due in the Department of Records and Registration on or before Saturday, May 18, 2019.
6. All grades will be given only in strict compliance with Law Center regulations.
7. Students must use their Personal Identification Numbers (PIN) to identify their examination answers and should be reminded that PINs will be distributed via email.
8. Please refer to the examination conflict policy for examination conflict. Conflict examinations will be given on Saturday, May 4, 2019. The absolute last date to request to take an examination on the conflict day is April 6, 2019.

*****Please be reminded that a time block reserved for an examination does not require the professor to give an examination of that length. Please check with your professor to verify the actual time length that will be used for the examination.*****
