- Formularies can be found in the Ready Reference Section, the Reserve Reading Room, and the first and second floors of the East Stacks.

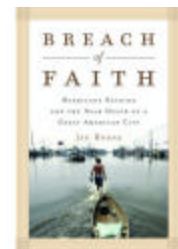
## One Book, One Community
