### **Winners Announced for 2010 Writing Competition**

Third-year student Keith Anderson and Channette Lewis, '10, have been named the winners of the 2010 SULC Nathan Burkan Memorial Writing Competition.

This competition is sponsored by the American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP). Students write scholarly papers on any aspect of copyright law.

Anderson's paper, "Copyright and Computer-Generated Speech, or The Curious Case of the Kindle," won first prize. The St. Francisville, Louisiana, native will receive a check from ASCAP for \$600.

Lewis's paper, "Are the Protections Under the Visual Artists Rights Act (VARA) Sufficient to Protect Artists from Infringement?" won the \$250 second prize. Lewis is a resident of Hephibah, Georgia.

Prof. Ruby Andrew coordinated the competition and served as a judge. Profs. Paul Race and Gail Stephenson served as additional judges.
