Clinic Policy on Conflict of Interest**

Purpose of the Policy

The purpose of this policy is to establish a standard to prevent conflicts of interests between Law Center clinic professors/attorneys and clinic clients.

Conflict of Interest Policy

A Southern University Law Center clinic professor/attorney shall not, at any time, for their own pecuniary interest, provide private legal services to any client that originates from the clinical client data base maintained by the Southern University Law Center clinic.


Application of Policy

This policy applies to all clinical professors of law.

The administration of this policy lies with the Director of the Southern University Law Center Clinic.

The responsibility for periodic review of this policy lies with the Vice-Chancellor for Institutional Accountability and Accreditation.
