2. In all courses, students who are graduating must inform their professors of this status by indicating on their examination – “graduation senior.”
3. Final grades for “graduating students” must be submitted to the Office of Enrollment as soon as possible, but no later than Friday, April 29, 2016.
4. Classes will end for first and second year students on Thursday, April 22, 2016.
5. Final grades for first and second year students are due in the Office of Enrollment on or before Friday, May 20, 2016.
8. All grades will be given only in strict compliance with Law Center regulations.
9. All students are to report to the Office of Records and Registration to obtain Personal Identification Numbers (PIN) on the date and time designated by the office.
