I. Policy Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to inform students of when students can be readmitted to Southern University Law Center (SULC) after having been dismissed from the program of legal education.

II. Policy Scope

This policy applies to students.

III. Policy Compliance

This policy informs students of when students can be readmitted to SULC after having been dismissed from the program of legal education.

IV. Policy Definitions

V. Policy Development and Implementation Procedure

The policy was created by the SULC administration and faculty to inform students of when students can be readmitted to SULC after having been dismissed from the program of legal education. The Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs is charged with implementing and enforcing this policy.

VI. Policy and Applicable Procedures

A student who has been dismissed from SULC may apply for readmission as an entering student. Readmission may be conditioned on pursuit of a special program of study. SULC recommends that a student delay applying for readmission for at least two years if the student has previously been disqualified for academic reasons. The two-year period begins on the date of the original determination to disqualify the student for academic reasons.

VII. Policy History and Review

This policy was created and became effective prior to the implementation of the uniform policy format which was implemented in 2019. The policy is subject to a five-year policy review cycle and shall be reviewed by the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and any changes will be submitted to the faculty for consideration.
