SULC 20-HOUR WORK WEEK POLICY

- A. First year full-time students are not allowed to work in a job, internal or external to the Law Center, during the academic semester unless the student obtains written permission from the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs.
- B. Full-time students who have completed their first year of study may work no more than 20 hours in a job, internal or external to the Law Center, during the academic semester unless the student obtains written permission from the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs.
- C. Part-time students are not limited in the number of hours that they can work during an academic semester.
- D. Students transferring from part-time to full-time status must declare adherence to this policy when applying for the change in status.
- E. This policy will be reviewed by the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs every two years to determine if the policy should be updated.
- F. This policy will become effective for the spring 2015 semester.
- G. The date of this policy is: January 1, 2015.
