Chancellor's Public Service Initiative

It is our desire at Southern University Law Center that our students will return to their communities, equipped with a legal education, and ready to pursue goals that include public service. In furtherance of achieving these goals, the Law Center offers summer stipends, in the amount of \$2,500.00, to students that meet certain academic criteria and that have committed themselves to working in an unpaid public interest or other service-oriented summer law internships.

In order to be considered as a candidate for receipt of these funds, the student must comply with the following requirements:

- (1) complete the attached application;
- (2) provide a copy of an official or unofficial transcript;
- be a rising 2L, 3L, or 4L at the end of the spring semester, and be in good academic standing at the time of application;
- (4) work in a legal or law-related position that is uncompensated by funds;
- perform a minimum of two hundred forty (240) hours of eligible work between May 3, 2020 and August 24, 2020 (you must be able to commit at least 10-15 hours a week to the agency of your choice);
- (6) work under the supervision of a licensed attorney; and
- (7) work in a position with an agency, organization, or firm in a program designed to directly or indirectly address the legal needs of poor persons, underrepresented groups; federal, state, or local government agencies; judicial entities; or organizations devoted to issues such as the preservation of the environment and the elimination of all forms of discrimination.


Stipends will be awarded to students that meet the above requirements on a "first come, first served" basis, depending upon available funding. THE STIPEND IS SIMILAR TO A SCHOLARSHIP AND, AS SUCH, IT WILL BE COUNTED AS PART OF YOUR SUMMER FINANCIAL AID BUDGET. IF YOU HAVE MAXED OUT YOUR FINANCIAL AID WITH SUMMER LOANS, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO RECEIVE THE STIPEND.
