Southern University Law Center (SULC) is pleased to announce that it is currently seeking applicants for at least two tenure-track appointments for its full-time faculty starting in August 2022.

SULC's mission and tradition has been to provide access and opportunity to a diverse group of students from underrepresented racial, ethnic, and socio-economic groups to obtain a high quality legal education with special emphasis on the Louisiana civil law. Due to an increasing number of students who plan to practice outside of Louisiana, SULC is developing a common-law track and seeks professors to teach in a number of common-law subjects. While our primary needs are in these areas, we welcome candidates who are also versed in teaching civil law subjects and legal writing.

A candidate must have a J.D. degree from an ABA-accredited law school and a commitment to teaching in an environment dedicated to excellence in teaching and mentoring of students. We will consider both lateral and entry-level applicants. We look for innovative faculty with a preference for both practice and teaching experience, and with either an established record or promise of legal scholarship. Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to service to legal education and to the wider community as well as a desire to engage in the intellectual life of the Law Center. With one of the most diverse student bodies in the country, SULC is dedicated to the aims of diversity and strongly encourages applications from women and minorities.

SULC is a member of the Association of American Law Schools (AALS). Established in 1947 in response to a lawsuit by an African-American resident seeking to attend law school at a state institution, SULC has grown to serve a widely diverse population of over 800 students. We are uniquely attuned to the importance of an education for students of all backgrounds and circumstances.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications. SULC also offers full-time faculty summer research grants, travel support, and research assistants.
